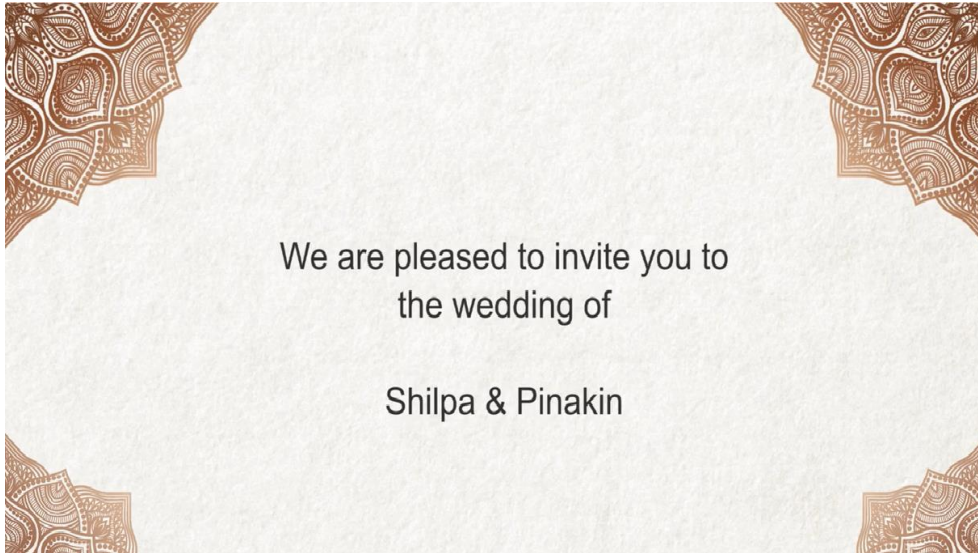


A Hindu Wedding
